Campers live in cozy cabins on Cabin Row. Each cabin has heating, air conditioning, and bathrooms with showers. Linens and towels are provided. Each bed is topped with a unique handmade quilt and a turtle pillow for campers to take home as a reminder of Camp all year long!

Nutritious Meals

To ensure campers stay fueled for fun, meals are enjoyed together in the Dining Hall. The menu is healthy, kid-friendly, and delicious. Snacks are available as needed, and filtered water is provided in every area of Camp. Special diets are accommodated: staff work with parents prior to each session to assure dietary needs and restrictions are met.

Dedicated Counselors

Staff and volunteers come from all over the world for one reason: to provide an amazing experience for campers. Each staff member and volunteer must complete an intensive interview process, a background check, and a thorough orientation. Some counselors may even have a serious illness themselves.

The Painted Turtle does not have a billing department. Camp is free of charge for campers and families. Because of the generosity of donors and supporters, we are able to offer the opportunity to experience intentional and exciting camp activities while receiving top-notch medical care — at no expense. We believe that every child should have a chance to just be a kid in a safe and empowering camp environment.

The Well Shell: Medical Care Around the Clock

The Well Shell is our 24-hour, state-of-the-art medical center. Disguised as a tropical paradise, our facility is equipped for everything from routine first-aid to dialysis treatments to emergency procedures. When campers visit the Well Shell, they aren't isolated from Camp fun — the walls are painted with murals, games are always on hand, and staff are trained to put smiles on campers' faces! Physicians and specialized medical professionals are ready to care for campers around the clock. The Painted Turtle employs a full-time

medical staff led by our Health Center Director and supported by our Medical Director. Nearly 200 physicians and nurses volunteer their time to support the full-time medical staff throughout the year, after completing a thorough application process. Each cabin is assigned a nurse to provide care, and he or she delivers medications and treatments during meals and/or to cabins to accommodate each camper's personal medical plan. Parents can rest assured their children will receive the finest medical care while at Camp!
